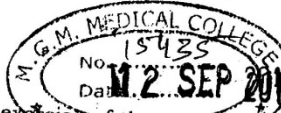

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of the section 11 of the Medical Council Act, 1956 (No. 102 of 1956), the Central Government, after consulting the Council of India, hereby makes the following further amendments in the First Schedule to said Act, due to change of affiliating University namely:-

In the said First Schedule before "Devi Ahilya Vishwa Vidyalaya, Indore" and there to "Madhya Pradesh Medical Science University, Jabalpur" shall be added and as "Madhya Pradesh Medical Science University, Jabalpur" under the heading 'Recognized Medical Qualification' [hereinafter referred to as column (2)] after the last entry and entry relating to under the heading 'Abbreviation for Registration' [hereinafter referred to as column (3)], following shall be inserted namely:-
